Offering a continuum of services from Early Intervention through specialized nursing care for adults with complex medical needs, we are helping individuals and their families lead fulfilling and fully-included lives.

#### Our services include:

• Early Intervention Services for children 0-3 years of age with identified disabilities such as Cerebral Palsy, Down syndrome and autism; or those with developmental delays or those at risk for delays in development due to risk factors related to birth and/or environmental circumstances

 The Learning Center, a fully inclusive community child-care program serving ages 15 months to 6 years
